



Setting the CHC Exam Passing Score

The task of setting the CHC Exam Passing (or Cut) Score was undertaken by an eight-member panel of CCH homeopaths. Assessment Systems, an internationally-recognized psychometric and testing consulting firm provided direction.

The Passing Score study set a benchmark on an 180-item score test form. Each test form includes up to 40 pilot items that are incorporated into future exams but do not affect examinee scores.

A modified Angoff methodology was used to review exam data. Based on this review, the panel recommended to the CHC Board that the CHC exam Passing (or Cut) Score be set at 255 (on a scaled score of 100 to 300). The CHC Board ratified the recommendation, and all versions of the CHC exam are statistically equated.
